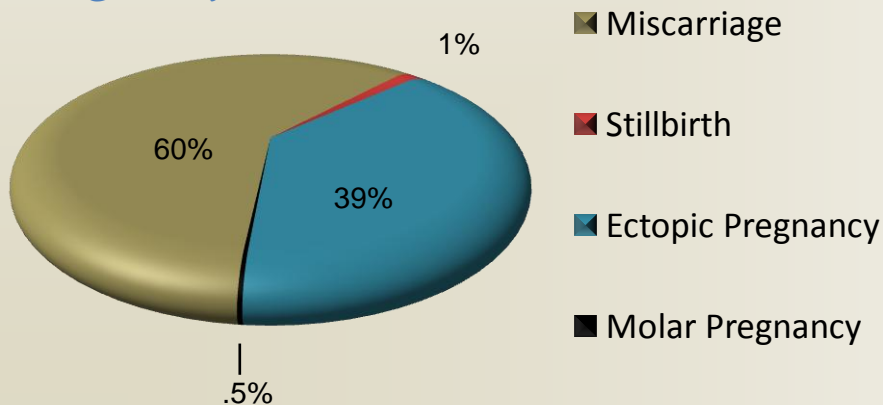
History

The Pregnancy Loss Center is a consultative service established to evaluate women who have experienced pregnancy loss. Findings from medical and obstetrical data suggest that while not all pregnancy loss can be prevented, many of the causative factors, once known, can be successfully treated.

Causes of Pregnancy Loss

Loss can occur at any time during the pregnancy. Numerous causes for pregnancy loss include genetic factors, blood clotting disorders, autoimmune diseases, environmental exposures, progesterone deficiency, structural abnormalities of the uterus/cervix, and maternal age.

Optimizing Outcome

The primary focus of care offered at our center is to provide you with a successful pregnancy outcome. We will work closely with your referring physician to determine the possible cause underlying your pregnancy loss. We will obtain a thorough history and make specific preconception recommendations regarding treatment options.
