- Estimated Fetal Weight (EFW)
- Why was Pitocin used
- Labor Abnormalities
- Length of 2<sup>nd</sup> stage
- Instrumental delivery – why, station and ease
- Position of vertex and which side was anterior
- Time of delivery
- Maneuvers used to reduce the shoulder in the order they were performed
- Who was there and who did what (nurses, anesthesiologist, pediatrician, students, patient's family)
- Time interval to deliver the shoulder
- Apgars, Weight, Cord gases
- Appearance of neonate in DR
